

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2133 AND ENACTING IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW ORDINANCE RELATING TO FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

Be it Ordained By The Board of Aldermen of the City of Brentwood, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 2133 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The Mayor, with the consent and approval of the majority of the members of the Board of Aldermen is hereby authorized to appoint a chief of the Fire Department, an Assistant Chief, Captains, and Lieutenants of the Fire Department, and as many additional regular firemen as may be deemed necessary.

Each shall serve during good behavior and may be removed at any time by and in conformity with the provisions of R.S. Mo. 1969, Section 79.240.

The Mayor, with the consent and approval of the majority members of the Board of Aldermen is hereby authorized to determine the rank and grade of service, as provided in Section 3 hereof, of all regular firemen and may, from time to time, promote or demote such firemen from rank to rank and grade to grade at will.

Any fireman, who shall be employed as Probationary Fireman at a rate 12% below Grade 2, shall, after the completion of six (6) months consecutive service in such grade, automatically and without further action by the Mayor or Board of Aldermen, attain and serve in the grade of Fireman, Grade 1.

Any fireman, who shall be employed as a Fireman, Grade 1, at a rate of 6% below Grade 2, shall, after the completion of six (6) months consecutive service in such grade, automatically attain and serve in the grade of Fireman, Grade 2.

Nothing herein shall be construed to limit the right of the Mayor, with the approval of the Board of Aldermen, to demote any regular fireman to the grade of Probationary Fireman.

SECTION 3. Exclusive of the Chief, Assistant Chief, and Captains of the Fire Department, all regular Firemen shall be ranked as follows:

- a) Lieutenant; or
- b) Fireman, Grade 2; or
- c) Fireman, Grade 1; or
- d) Probationary Fireman

SECTION 4. The following rates of compensation shall be paid Bi-weekly in equal installments to the following members of the Fire Department; providing that such rates of compensation may be changed from time to time by Ordinance:

1. To the Chief of the Fire Department, the sum of Twelve Hundred and Twenty Five Dollars (\$1225.00) per month.
2. To the Assistant Chief of the Fire Department, the sum of Ten Hundred and Seventy Two Dollars (\$1072.00) per month.
3. To the Captains of the Fire Department, the sum of Ten Hundred and Forty Seven Dollars (\$1047.00) per month.
4. To the Lieutenants of the Fire Department, the sum of Nine Hundred and Twenty Dollars (\$920.00) per month.
5. To Firemen, Grade 2, the sum of Eight Hundred and Seventy Five Dollars (\$875.00) per month.
6. To Firemen, Grade 1, a sum of 6% less than Grade 2, or Eight Hundred and Twenty Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$822.50) per month.
7. To Probationary Firemen, a sum of 12% less than Grade 2, or Seven Hundred and Seventy Dollars (\$770.00) per month.

All members of the Fire Department below the rank of Captain shall be paid for each hour worked for overtime beyond regular schedules of work, and all such members of the Fire Department below the rank of Captain shall be paid a sum equal to 1/30 of their regular rate of each day designated as a Holiday by Ordinance.

SECTION 5. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of April 1, 1975.
