

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20 OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD FOR 1969 BY REPEALING SECTION 20-24 OF SAID CHAPTER RELATING TO DESIGNATED LICENSE FEES FOR CERTAIN BUSINESSES AND OCCUPATIONS AND ENACTING IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW SECTION 20-24; PROVIDING FOR THE CURRENT MAINTENANCE OF THIS CODE; PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

Be It Ordained By The Board of Aldermen of the City of Brentwood, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 20 of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Brentwood for 1969 is hereby amended by repealing Section 20-24 of said Chapter and enacting in lieu thereof a new Section 20-24 of said Chapter relating to designated license fees for certain businesses and occupations to be in words and figures as follows:

Sec. 20-24. Designated.

The license fees for certain businesses, occupations, etc., per year, are specified as follows:

Amusement parks, miniature golf courses, trampoline parks and similar amusement park or devices, per year or any part thereof	\$150.00

SECTION 2. This ordinance must be construed in conjunction with Ordinance No. 2339.

SECTION 3. In conformity with the provisions of said Code, the City Administrator shall cause appropriate copies to be made hereof and shall insert such copies in each edition of said Code.


SECTION 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
