

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 1893 BY ELIMINATING THE WORDS "65TH" AND IN LIEU THEREOF INSERT THE WORDS "70TH" PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

Be It Ordained By The Board of Aldermen of the City of Brentwood, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1893 to be amended as follows:

Except as hereinafter provided, it shall be mandatory for all persons employed by the City of Brentwood to retire from employment by the City on the first day of April immediately following their 70th birthday; provided, however, that the provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to any City employee who, on the date this ordinance shall be enacted, shall be over the age of 70 years, nor shall this ordinance apply to any elected official.

SECTION 2. In conformity with the provisions of said Code, the City Administrator shall cause appropriate copies to be made hereof and shall insert such copies in each edition of said Code.


SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval according to law.
