AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-116 OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD FOR 1987, CONCERNING THE QUALIFICATIONS OF THE CITY CLERK/ADMINISTRATOR, PROVIDING FOR THE CURRENT MAINTENANCE OF THIS CODE; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the City of Brentwood deems it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Brentwood to amend Chapter 2 of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Brentwood for 1987 by repealing Section 2-116, and enacting in lieu thereof a new Sections 2-116 concerning the qualifications of the city clerk/administrator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2-116 of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Brentwood for 1987 is hereby amended by repealing the present Section 2-116 and enacting in lieu thereof a new Section 2-116, to read in its entirety in words and figures as follows:

**Sec. 2-116 Qualifications.**

The city clerk/administrator must be at least twenty-five (25) years old. The city clerk/administrator must be a graduate of an accredited university or college, with a major in public or municipal administration, or with equivalent qualifications and experience in financial or business administration, and/or public relations.

SECTION 2. In conformity with the provisions of said Code, the City Clerk/Administrator shall cause appropriate copies to be made hereof and shall insert such copies in each edition of said Code.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed. The provisions of this ordinance are declared to be



SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval according to law.
