AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD FOR 1987 BY CHANGING SECTIONS 2-62 THROUGH 2-75, RESERVED, TO SECTIONS 2-63 THROUGH 2-75 RESERVED, AND ADDING A NEW SECTION 2-62, ESTABLISHING A LOSS CONTROL COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR THE CURRENT MAINTENANCE OF THIS CODE; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Chapter 2 of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Brentwood for 1987 is hereby amended by changing sections 2-62 through 2-75, reserved, to sections 2-63 through 2-75 reserved.

SECTION TWO. Chapter 2 of the Revised Code of Ordinances of the City of Brentwood for 1987 is hereby amended by adding a new Section 2-62 to read in its entirety in words and figures as follows:

Sec. 2-62. Loss Control Committee.

- (a) There is established a Loss Control Committee.
- (b) The Committee shall have legislative oversight over measures to promote on the job safety for city employees.
- (c) The Loss Control Committee shall consist of all department heads, the Insurance Committee and a representative from the City's Workers' Compensation Insurance Carrier, as well as the City's insurance carrier(s) for general public liability and automobile liability.
- (d) The Committee shall meet to review and discuss loss control in the following manner:
  - (1) All department heads shall be required to meet on a monthly basis to review and discuss loss control and preventive safety measures.
  - (2) All department heads and the Insurance Committee shall meet four times per year to review loss control and establish procedures for employee on the job safety.

(3) All department heads, the Insurance Committee and a representative from the City's Workers' Compensation Insurance Carrier, as well as the City's insurance carrier(s) for general public liability and automobile liability, shall meet twice annually to review loss control and establish policies to ensure employee on the job safety.

(e) The representative from the City's Worker's Compensation Insurance Carrier, as well as the City's insurance carrier(s) for general public liability and automobile liability, shall be appointed by the Mayor with the consent and approval of the majority of the members of the board of aldermen.

SECTION THREE. In conformity with the provisions of said Code, the City/Clerk Administrator shall cause appropriate copies to be made hereof and shall insert such copies in each edition of said Code.

SECTION FOUR. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval according to law.
