AN ORDINANCE TO CONFIRM, RATIFY AND APPROVE THE RATE OF TAX TO BE ASSESSED AND COLLECTED FOR EACH ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) OF ASSESSED VALUATION FOR THE YEAR 1998 FOR: (A) GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES; (B) TO PAY PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST AS THE SAME MATURES ON INDEBTEDNESS OF THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD EVIDENCED BY BONDS; (C) TO PAY FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE PUBLIC LIBRARY; AND (D) TO PROVIDE THE ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION TO THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD'S POLICE AND FIREMEN'S RETIREMENT FUND; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

Be It Ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Brentwood, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1. General Fund - \$.22 There is hereby levied upon all mixed, personal and real property within the limits of the City of Brentwood, taxable according to the laws of this State, a tax for general municipal purposes for the year 1998, and thereafter, in the amount of and at the rate of \$.22 per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation of such property.

SECTION 2. Public Library - \$.19 In addition to the levies aforesaid, there is hereby levied upon all mixed, personal and real property within the limits of the City of Brentwood, taxable according to the laws of this State, a special Library Fund Tax for the year 1998 in the amount of and at the rate of \$.19 per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation of such property, for the establishment and maintenance of free public library in said City .

SECTION 3. Police and Firemen's Retirement Fund - \$.25 In addition to the levies aforesaid , there is hereby levied upon all mixed, personal and real property within the limits of the City of Brentwood, taxable according to the laws of this State, a special tax for the year 1998 in the amount of and at the rate of \$.25 per One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessed valuation of such property for the purpose of providing the annual contribution of the City to the Police and Firemen's Retirement Fund.

SECTION 4. Bonded Indebtedness - \$.00 There is hereby levied upon all mixed, personal and real property within the limits of the City of Brentwood, taxable according to the laws of this State, a tax to pay principal and interest as the same matures on indebtedness of the City of Brentwood evidenced by bonds for the year 1998, and thereafter, in the amount of and at the rate of \$.00 per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation of such property.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval according to law.

SECTION 6. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.


