

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR A **MID-BLOCK CROSSWALK ON OLD CHESTER-GLADSTONE ROAD**, IN THE TOWNSHIP OF CHESTER, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

**Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Chester, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:**

Section I - That a mid block cross walk, across **Old Chester-Gladstone Road** be hereby established at **approximately 178 feet northwest of the northerly edge of pavement of Pottersville Road. (also approximately 14 feet northwest of the edge of pavement of the access road to. Route 206)...**

Section II - That the crosswalk markings shall be installed in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Section III - That signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designated crosswalk in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways and the guidelines set forth by the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation.

Section IV - This Ordinance shall take effect pursuant to N.J.S.A 39:4-86 (3) and N.J. S.A. 40:49-2.
