

**ORDINANCE 2014-11**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER, MORRIS COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, ALLOCATING THE SUM OF \$463,000.00 OF WHICH \$80,000.00 IS FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT FUND FOR OLD GLADSTONE ROAD AND \$383,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER, FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF OLD GLADSTONE ROAD, BUDD AVENUE, CHERRY STREET AND GROVE STREET OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER, MORRIS COUNTY, NEW JERSEY.**

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Chester deem it to be in the best interests of the Borough of Chester to provide for capital improvements to various roads, and

WHEREAS, monies are available for certain projects from 2014 Budget Appropriation, and/or previous budget appropriated in the Capital Improvement Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Chester, in the county of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1:** There is here by allocated the sum of \$463,000.00 as follows:

- a. The sum of \$383,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the improvement of Budd Avenue, Chery Street, Grove Street & Old Gladstone Road.
- b. The sum of \$80,000.00 from the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation for the improvement of Old Gladstone road.

**Section 2:** The General Fund Capital Budget of the Borough of Chester is hereby amended to conform with provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, are on file with the Borough Clerk and are available for inspection.

**Section 3:** This Ordinance shall become effective after final passage by the Mayor and Council in accordance with law.
