

**ORDINANCE 2016 – 03**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER, MORRIS COUNTY, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ALLOCATING THE SUM OF \$216,795.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL ACCOUNT FOR THE CAPITAL EQUIPMENT PURCHASES AND IMPROVEMENT TO THE BOROUGH AND EQUIPMENT PURCHASE FOR CHESTER VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY AND FIRST AID SQUAD.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Chester deem it to be in the best interests of the Borough of Chester to provide for certain capital improvements, and

**WHEREAS**, monies are available for certain projects from the General Capital fund,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Chester, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** There is hereby allocated from the General Capital Account, the sum of \$216,795.00 from capital improvement fund for the improvements and equipment purchase as follows:

Defibrillators  
Public Works Truck  
Volunteer Fire Co. Equipment  
Salt Bin  
Roller

**Section 2.** The Capital Budget of the Borough of Chester is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, are on file with the Borough Clerk and are available for inspection.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall become effective after final passage by the Mayor and Council in accordance with law.
