

**ORDINANCE 2019 -14**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CHESTER, MORRIS COUNTY, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 127 “FEES” ADDING A FEE FOR BANNER INSTALLATION AND REMOVAL OVER MAIN STREET AND ADDING A FEE FOR TRASH REMOVAL AFTER SPECIAL EVENTS/FARMERS MARKETS.**

**WHEREAS**, municipalities are empowered to make, amend, repeal, and enforce its ordinances pursuant to Statute (N.J.S.A. 40:48-1, et seq.); and

**WHEREAS**, municipalities are required by Statute to follow specific procedures for the passage of ordinances (N.J.S.A. 40:49-2 et seq.); and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that Chapter 127 of the Code of the Borough of Chester relative to fees associated with permits for temporary banners and fees associated with trash removal after farmer’s markets and special events needs to be revised;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Borough of Chester, County of Morris, State of New Jersey that the Borough Code is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Chapter 127, Article I, Section 127-1, is hereby amended to include the following:

Chapter 163	§163-90(D)	Temporary Banners	\$ 50
Chapter 202	§202-9(A)	Fee for Clean-up and Removal of Trash and Debris After Farmer’s Markets	\$350
Chapter 203	§203-7(A)	Fee for Clean-up and Removal of Trash and Debris After Special Events	\$350

**SECTION 2:** The first sentence of Sub-section D(8) of Chapter 163 (Land Use and Development Procedures), Article XII (Zoning – Signs), Section 90 (Temporary Signs) shall be revised to include a fee for temporary banners, to read as follows:

§163-90(D)(8) There shall be a fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for a permit to erect the banner.

**SECTION 3:** If any Chapter, Article, Section or Subsection, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction such decisions shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4:** All ordinances or rules or regulations of the Borough of Chester, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 5:** This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
