RESOLUTION NO. 2019-15**

INTRODUCED AUGUST 13, 2019

ADOPTED BY COUNCIL AUGUST 13, 2019

WHEREAS, by Resolution of September 22, 2014, Resolution 14-15, the Borough Council of the Borough of Columbia established a Highway Capital Improvement Fund; and

WHEREAS, no funds have been dispersed from said Fund; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the revenues from the liquid fuels tax are sufficient to meet the needs of the Borough respecting highway maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the best interests of the Borough would be furthered by removing restrictions upon the expenditure of the funds; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council has been advised that a Resolution is necessary in order to rescind the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, this 13TH day of August 2019, it is hereby resolved as follows:

Resolution 14-15 establishing a Highway Capital Improvement Fund is hereby **RESCINDED**.

The directives set forth therein requiring deposits to be made in the Fund are declared to be of no effect.

The Borough Manager is directed to take such actions as are necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.
