**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-07**

**ADOPTED BY COUNCIL March 24, 2020**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of Columbia Borough (the "Borough") declared a State of Emergency effective 6:00 am on March 17, 2020 in accordance with the Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S. § 10A06;

**WHEREAS**, Section 10A06 of the Borough Code empowers the Borough to extend the state of emergency by resolution of Borough Council;

**WHEREAS**, Borough Council finds that there is a continued threat to public health and safety due to the spread of the COVID-19, also known as Coronavirus, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

**WHEREAS**, the aforesaid threat warrants and necessitates an extension of the State of Emergency within the Borough;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Borough Council of Columbia Borough, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. The State of Emergency for Columbia Borough shall be extended until April 30, 2020.
2. Borough residents are encouraged to follow the direction of public health officials in curbing the spread of the COVID-19 virus and ensure the health and safety of our community members.
