

**BOROUGH OF COLUMBIA

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-13**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of Columbia Borough (the "Borough") declared a State of Emergency effective 6:00 am on March 17, 2020 in accordance with the Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S. § 10A06;

**WHEREAS**, the current State of Emergency that was adopted by Resolution 2020-12 expires on June 10, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, Section 10A06 of the Borough Code empowers the Borough to extend the state of emergency by resolution of Borough Council;

**WHEREAS**, Borough Council finds that there is a continued threat to public health and safety due to the spread of the COVID-19, also known as Coronavirus, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and


**WHEREAS**, the aforesaid threat warrants and necessitates an extension of the State of Emergency within the Borough;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Borough Council of Columbia Borough, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:


1. The State of Emergency for Columbia Borough shall be extended until **July 15, 2020**.
2. Borough residents are encouraged to follow the direction of public health officials in curbing the spread of the COVID-19 virus and ensure the health and safety of our community members.
