Your service days will be Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Please see the attached street listing for your service day. Trash must be placed at the curb no later than 6:00am on your scheduled day of collection.

Severe winter weather can be a challenge to our daily operations. Every decision we make is for the safety of the community, its residents and our employees.

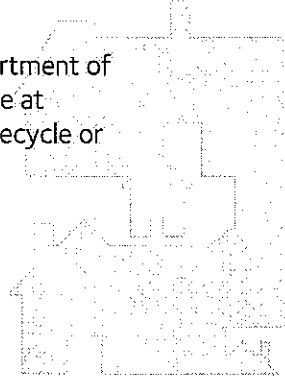

ITEMS NOT COLLECTED:

The following items will not be collected as part of the regular waste collection:

- Construction/demolition materials
- Automotive parts
- Household hazardous wastes (paint, oil, flammables, hot ash, etc.)
- Dirt, stone, concrete, rock
- Medical wastes
- Materials from fire or evictions
- Tires
- Pesticides/insecticides
- Antifreeze
- Electronics

Home Pickup Program for Household Hazardous Waste Begins January 1, 2018

As part of the residential solid waste and recycling contract with Waste Management, you have a convenient new opportunity to dispose of your Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) safely, easily and responsibly. Introducing At Your Door Special CollectionSM, a new residential service offered by WM to provide year-round HHW collections for you.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. To participate, you must set up a collection appointment

There are three ways to schedule a collection:

The Call Center operators will guide you through the steps toward a safe and successful collection. You will be asked several questions, including your address and the type and amount of materials available for collection. You will be provided a convenient collection date and information about where to place the HHW kit for collection. A kit will be sent to your home in plenty of time for you to gather and pack your materials.

2. Preparing for collection

The HHW kit includes a program instruction sheet and other items to help pack and secure household hazardous waste. All materials such as gasoline, poisons, pesticides and aerosols, must be placed into the kit. Other items may be placed outside the kit.

3. HHW material is collected

On the scheduled date, the customer service technician will collect materials directly from your home. They will sort and pack the materials for proper transportation, recycling and disposal. Participants will receive a postage-paid survey card to complete and mail back to help track the program.

4. You have more material than will fit into the kit?

Don't worry! This service is available year-round. Just schedule another collection once you have more material to dispose of.

The Call Center operators are available from Monday - Friday 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM Eastern time.

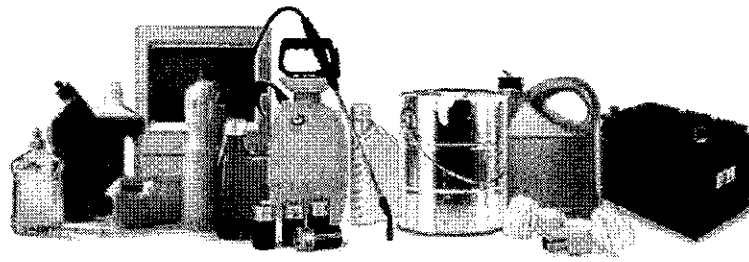
