NEW BUSINESS

The first item under new business motion/discussion on two applications for the Allegheny County Vacant Property Recovery Program. Resolution 8-2020 for the property 702-D-177 on Work Street, Crescent, PA. Resolution 9-2020 for property 702-D-174 1325 Main Street Crescent, PA. Commissioner Miller made the motion Seconded by Commissioner Keller. A roll call was taken and all commissioners were in favor.

The second item under new business motion/discussion for Conversion Program from Duquesne Light Co. to convert 10 consecutive street lights to LED at a cost of \$1,090.00. Commissioner Miller stated that we have been doing this and it will save the Township Money. The commissioners agreed to finish any lights that were not changed to LED on McGovern Blvd. and continue the next 10 on Bocktown Road. Commissioner Miller made the motion Seconded by Commissioner Buccigrossi. A roll call was taken and all commissioners were in favor.

The third item motion/discussion on change order on Gazebo. Solicitor Start said that there was no need to change anything the plans were already accepted. No action was taken.

The fourth item was a motion to accept the rescinded resignation of Officer Trevon Williams. Commissioner Keller made the motion Seconded by Commissioner Withee. A roll call was taken and all commissioners were in favor.

The fifth and final item on the agenda was a Motion to accept a contract extension from Cargill for the remainder of rock salt that we are required to purchase for the Township. They have agreed to store the salt from the 2019-2020 winter season. Commissioner Miller stated that as soon as we get the new salt shed erected we will not need this service. Commissioner Miller made the motion Seconded by Commissioner Withee. A roll call was taken and all commissioners were in favor.
