A Regular Meeting of the East Pennsboro Township Board of Commissioners was held on Wednesday, October 18, 2017, at 7:30 p.m. at the Community and Municipal Center, 98 S. Enola Drive, Enola, Pennsylvania.

I. CALL TO ORDER

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND APPROVAL

MOTION to adopt Ordinance No. 796-17 providing for the amendment and revision of Ordinance 757-2009, Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances regarding the Animal Control Ordinance, was made by Mr. Gelb, seconded by Ms. Magaro, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.

MOTION to adopt Ordinance No. 797-17 of the Township of East Pennsboro, Cumberland County, providing for the amendment and revision of Ordinance No.757-2009, Chapter 20, Part 2, Solid Waste and Recycling, was made by Ms. Magaro, seconded by Mr. Hartman, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.

MOTION to adopt Ordinance No. 798-17 of the Township of East Pennsboro, Cumberland County, providing for the amendment and revision of Ordinance 757-2009, Chapter 15, Part 9, Snow Emergency Route, was made by Mr. Gelb, seconded by Ms. Magaro, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.
