A Regular Meeting of the East Pennsboro Township Board of Commissioners was held on Wednesday, November 15, 2017, at 7:30 p.m. at the Community and Municipal Center, 98 S. Enola Drive, Enola, Pennsylvania.

Those present were: Commissioners – John Kuntzelman, President; Paul Hartman, Vice President; George Tyson, Kristy Magaro, and Charles Gelb; John Pietropaoli, Township Manager; Lisa M. Coyne, Esquire, Township Solicitor; John B. Owen, Codes Enforcement Officer; Jared Hockenberry, Township Engineer; Dearan Quigley, Director, Housing & Community Development; Mike Dobson, Parks Department; Andy Kirkessner, WWTP; Chief Bashore and Lieutenant Mark Green, Police Department; and Erik Owen, Fire Marshal.

I. CALL TO ORDER

President Kuntzelman called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. A Moment of silent meditation was observed, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

II. BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR

There was no business from the floor.

III. PRESENTATION

Mr. Justin Shaulis, from the Cumberland County Department of Public Safety, awarded the PEMA Municipal Advanced Certification to Erik Owen. He noted for the board the rigor and commitment one must possess in order to earn the certification by taking 80 hours of online training as well as 40 hours of classroom training.

Chief Bashore noted Anthony Fiore will be sworn in December 6, and the complement after Justin Barder's appointment means they can start the Holy Spirit agreement, although they would have to replace any future retirements.

Mr. Pietropaoli noted for the record the board will hold a short Executive Session with the Police Department on personnel matters after adjournment.
