A Regular Meeting of the East Pennsboro Township Board of Commissioners was held on Monday, January 15, 2020, at 7:30 p.m. at the Community and Municipal Center, 98 S. Enola Drive, Enola, Pennsylvania.

Those present were: Commissioners - George Tyson, President; Raymond "Skip" Magaro, Vice President; Kristy Magaro, Charles Gelb and Walter "Joe" Fidler; John Pietropaoli, Township Manager; Lisa Coyne, Township Solicitor; John B. Owen, Assistant Township Manager; Ed Meyers, WWTP; Chief Mark Green, Police Department; and Erik Owen, Fire Marshal.

I. CALL TO ORDER

President Tyson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. A moment of silent meditation was observed, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

II. APPROVAL OF REPORTS

MOTION approving the Police Report for November/December 2019, was made by Ms. Magaro, seconded by Mr. Skip Magaro, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

MOTION approving the minutes of the Regular Meeting for January 6, 2020, was made by Mr. Fidler, seconded by Ms. Magaro, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.

IV. BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR

Mr. Gene Assante, 817 Acri Road, asked for an update on the speaker system for the meeting room. Mr. Quigley stated they will test the system next Friday. All pieces will be in place.

V. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND APPROVAL

MOTION authorizing payment of invoices and payroll pending review and signatures of Commissioners, was made by Ms. Magaro, seconded by Mr. Fidler, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.

MOTION to draft and advertise the restrictions to Chapter 7, Fire Prevention and Fire Protection section of the codified code, as recommended by Fire Chief Owen, was made by Ms. Magaro, seconded by Mr. Skip Magaro, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.

MOTION to adopt Resolution 815-2020 of the Township of East Pennsboro, Cumberland County, which updates the FRAC organizational policy as submitted by the Township Fire Chief, was made by Ms. Magaro, seconded by Mr. Skip Magaro, and was carried by a unanimous aye vote.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

The board reviewed the Commissioner appointments and will have selections made by the next meeting.

Mr. Pietropaoli noted the township will have a blood drive on Monday, January 20, in the Commissioners' meeting room from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Lucky Penny burgers will be served from the food truck outside.

Mr. Owen announced there are vacancies on some township boards, two on the Zoning Hearing Board, one on the Industrial Commercial Development Authority, and one on the West Shore Authority. The letters for reappointments went out today.
