An Emergency Meeting of the East Pennsboro Township Board of Commissioners was held on Sunday, March 22, 2020 at the Emergency Operation Center at the Community and Municipal Center, 98 S. Enola Drive, Enola, Pennsylvania.

I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by President Tyson followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

III. Solicitor Coyne explained the proposed Declaration of Disaster Emergency Relating to COVID-19 Pandemic under consideration by the Board of Commissioners during this Emergency Meeting will continue the previously issued Declaration of Emergency; however, this Declaration will continue beyond today's effective date until terminated by the Board of Commissioners rather than terminating automatically after seven days. The Disaster Emergency Declaration also provides for future public meetings during the term of the COVID-19 Pandemic Emergency to be conducted via teleconference or other electronic methods that allows for two-way communication between and among the Commissioners, staff, and the public. Manager Pietropaoli advised that for meetings of the Board of Commissioners conducted during this declared COVID-19 Pandemic, the

Agenda will be posted on the website prior to the meeting and public can provide email comments which will be printed and/or read at the meeting to become part of the minutes. The staff will be working with the Solicitor to provide additional guidance as to format of the meetings to ensure public participation in a manner which recognizes appropriate safety measures to reduce risk of COVID-19 to residents, Township Staff, and elected officials.
