

ORDINANCE NO. 936

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ELIZABETH, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY,
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF ___
ROADS MAINTAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP PRIOR TO THE ADOPTION OF ___
FORMAL PUBLIC ROAD STANDARDS**

WHEREAS, the Township of Elizabeth has maintained for use by the public ___ roads (“Roads”) located in the Fox Run Development which were constructed in whole or in part prior to the adoption of formal road construction standards by the Township; and

WHEREAS, some of the Roads in the Development do not meet the construction standards which have been adopted by the Township standards and the Township has no plan now or in the future to construct new roads to replace the Roads described herein; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 22, Part 2 of the Township of Elizabeth Code of Ordinances as revised through July 5, 2011 defines a public street to include any street that has been “devoted to public use by...use or other means” and therefore includes the Roads described herein; and

WHEREAS, the Elizabeth Township Board of Commissioners wishes to accept the dedication of the Roads listed below for purposes of recognizing their continuing status as public roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the authority of the Elizabeth Township Board of Commissioners as follows:

Section 1. The Elizabeth Township Board of Commissioners accepts the dedication of the following Roads in their entirety or as otherwise described herein:


1. Ash Drive
2. Birch Drive
3. Cedar Drive
4. Hickory Circle
5. Maple Circle
6. Oak Circle
7. Teak Road
8. Walnut Circle

Section 2. Any ordinance or part thereof in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.
