Dear Ms. Whiteman:

Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC is proposing to replace two gas lines, one on and one below the Boston Hollow Road Culvert in Elizabeth Township and Lincoln Borough, Allegheny County. Proposed construction will include the installation and attachment of two new gas lines along the UNT to Boston Hollow Run, restoration, and all other appurtenances necessary. As part of the project, the Developer is applying for two General Permit No. 5 Registrations for Utility Line Stream Crossings. Enclosed for your reference is a copy of the General Permit Registration Form, Site Location Map, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PaDEP) Appendix A – Land Use Information Questionnaire, and Appendix C – Municipal Land Use Letter.

This notice is required pursuant to Act 14, P.L. 834, which became effective April 17, 1984. Act 14 requires written notification be provided to each local municipality and county in which the permitted activity is located. The written notice is to be received by the local municipality and county at least 30 days before PaDEP issues or denies the permit.

Acts 67, 68 and 127 of 2000, which amended the Municipalities Planning Code (MPC) to direct state agencies to consider comprehensive plans and zoning ordinances when reviewing applications for permitting of facilities or infrastructure, and specify that state agencies may rely upon comprehensive plans and zoning ordinances under certain conditions as described in Sections 619.2 and 1105 of the MPC.



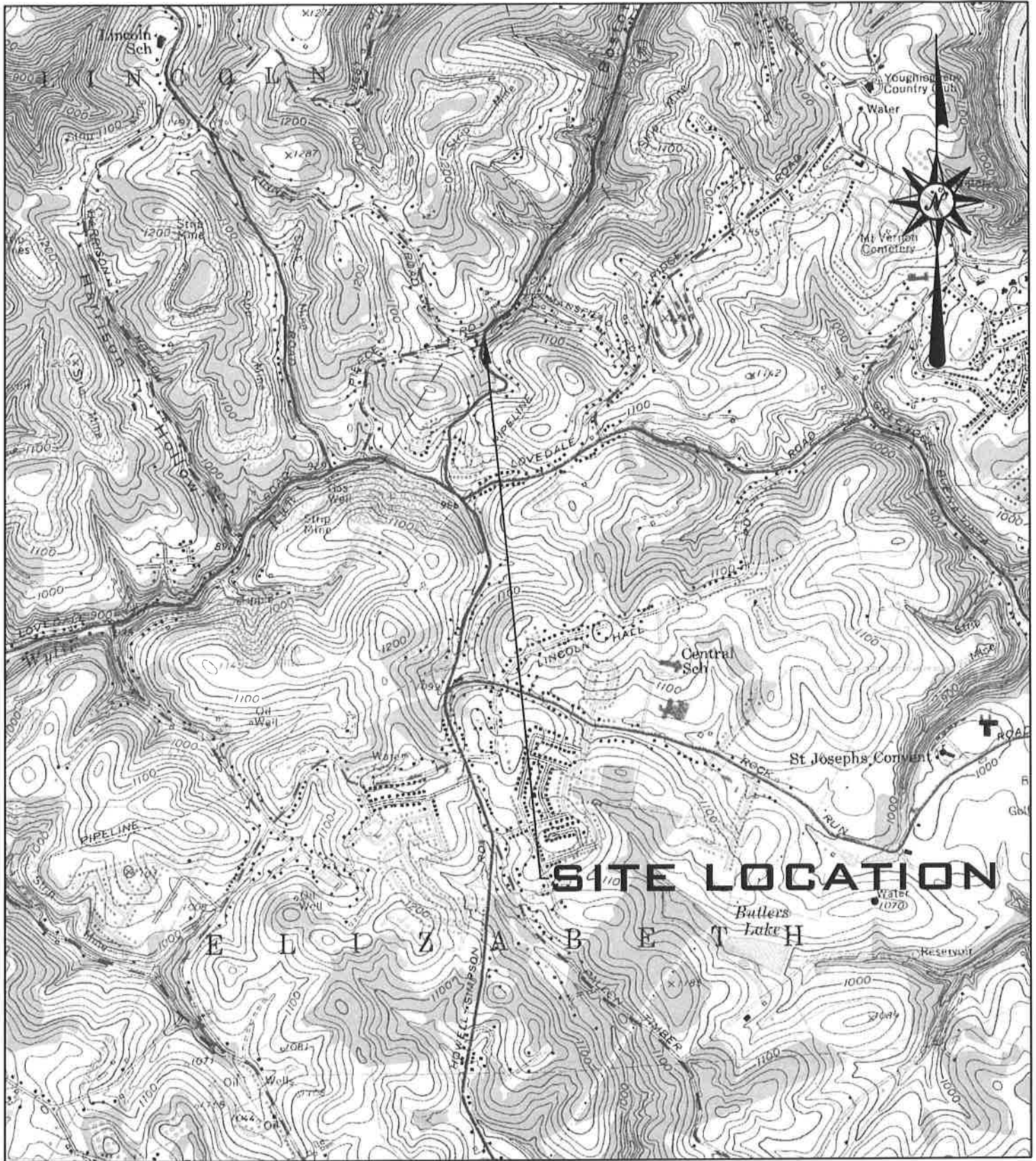
