ORDINANCES: FOR FIRST READING

1. Council File No. 15,604

An ordinance amending the City of Erie streets, utilities and public services code, article 955 (**Parks and Playground Areas**) Section 955.07 (Behavior) by adding Sub-Section 955.07 (j) (Consumption of Alcoholic beverages prohibited) to prohibit the consumption of alcoholic beverages and possession of open containers of alcoholic beverages in City parks and playgrounds, to provide for definitions and to provide for exceptions and by amending Section 955.99 (Penalty) to increase the fine provision.

An ordinance appropriating the sum of \$60,000.00 from unappropriated and unanticipated revenue and providing for the expenditure thereof. In the **Capital Improvement Fund** for use of replacement of a roof at **Firehouse #13**.
