RE: Eben Brewer Statue

On the Agenda for the December 2, 2009 City Council meeting is a purchase order in the amount of \$5,000.00 to move the Eben Brewer Statue from Perry Square to Griswold Park in 1849 in Barnet, Vermont, settled in Erie and was a publisher and manager of the Erie Dispatch. His father, ex-Congressman Francis B. Brewer, of New York, organized the first petroleum company in the United States and was responsible for the first oil well bored in Titusville, Pa.

Eben Brewer enlisted in the Spanish American War and due to his experience with the German Feldpost (Army post office) in Europe, he was the first person assigned the post of resident mail agent in Cuba. He died in combat on July 14, 2898, and is buried at Arlington National Cemetery. The statue was erected in Perry Square by the Postal Employees of the United State and was dedicate during the U. S. Postmasters' Convention that was held in Erie in 1907.

The original plans for the Griswold Park renovation project included moving the Eben Brewer statue to the front of the Griswold Park Post office. However, this item was removed from the project as grant funding was unable to cover the cost of the moving of the statue. If you have any questions, please contact me at 870-1451.
