E. ORDINANCES: FOR FINAL PASSAGE

- 1. Council File No. 15,801, Pending Official File Ordinance No. 20-2012
An Ordinance of the City Council of this City of Erie (The "City") determining to incur lease rental debt; evidence by the guaranteed revenue note in the maximum principal amount of **\$8,915,618** to be authorized and issued by Erie City Water Authority in connection with the construction, alteration and improvements to the public water distribution facilities in and about this City, and paying related costs, fees and expenses; specifying the realistic useful life of the project; authorizing and directing appropriate officers of the City to take certain actions and to execute certain documents, including a guaranty agreement, between the City, as guarantor and the Erie City Water Authority, and the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority; approving the form, maximum guaranteed amounts and sources of payment of the guaranty agreement, creating a sinking fund in connection with such guaranty obligations and appointing a sinking fund depository and providing for the repeal of all inconsistent ordinances or parts of ordinances.
