E. ORDINANCES: FOR FINAL PASSAGE:

1. Council File Ordinance #15,702, Pending Official File Ordinance #6-2010
an ordinance appropriating the sum of **\$40,000.00** from unappropriated and anticipated revenue from Account #267-0613-2009-3336 Project Safe Neighborhood and providing for the expenditure thereof by allocating said sum to Account #267-0613-2009 in the Bureau of Police, specifically, #4006 Overtime - \$26,200.00; #4016 FICA/Medicare Taxes - \$200.00; #4021 Valic - \$600.00; #4039 - Consumable Items - \$8,902.00; #4059 Other Services & Charges - \$4,098.00.

ORDINANCES: FOR FIRST READING:

1. Council File Ordinance #15,703
an ordinance appropriating the sum of **\$2,050,000.00** from appropriated and anticipated revenue from Account #460-0000-0000-3111 Debt Service Fund Balance and providing for the expenditure thereof by allocating said sum to Account #460-1061-0000-3930 Operating Transfer - Water Reserve Fund.
2. Council File Ordinance #15,704
an ordinance amending Official Ordinance #72-2009 **Prohibition of Driving with Hand-Held Mobile Phones**, by making violations secondary to another violation of motor vehicle law, specifically
"No person shall be convicted of a violation of this Ordinance unless the person is also convicted of a violation of law involving a moving vehicle committed at the same time as the use of a hand-held mobile phone."

F. OLD BUSINESS

The following two resolutions were withdrawn at the request of their sponsors at the Council meeting of February 3, 2010:

1. Resolution sponsored by Councilman Mark Aleksandrowicz respectfully requesting the Department of Economic & Community Development to add the following requirements to all requests to purchase **repository sale property** within the City of Erie:
 - a) That each prospective bidder or purchaser supply two forms of identification, one being a photo ID and
 - b) Provide proof of Corporation Company, address or residence with insurance forms, utility bills or other forms of verification if such legal entity is being used to hold property that is being bid upon.This additional information is to be included in all information packages that are forwarded to City Council for their review and approval from the Department of Economic and Community Development.
2. Resolution sponsored by Councilman James Thompson approving the following properties for Repository Sale to **Robert Bonaccolta** of America's Private Housing and Redevelopment for the sum of \$250.00 each:
721 East 25th Street, Index #18-050-031.0-114.00
1325 East 10th Street, Index #15-021-002.1-304.00

G. NEW BUSINESS

1. Resolution sponsored by Councilman Patrick Cappabianca respectfully requesting the Erie County delegation to the Pennsylvania General Assembly support and adopt the **Family & Business Health Security Act**, being SB 400 and HB 1660 that provides affordable, comprehensive health care for every Pennsylvanian by covering essential medical expenses.
2. Resolution sponsored by Councilman Patrick Cappabianca appointing Kathy Horan, 509 Maryland Avenue, to the **Erie Regional Airport Authority** to fill the unexpired term of Sumner Nichols (resigned), to expire on December 31, 2012.
3. Resolution closing out Community Conservation Partnerships Grant Project BRC-TA-12-236 regarding the City of Erie's preparation of a Master Site Plan for **McClelland Park** to identify current conditions and land uses and to recommend protection, development and maintenance options financed in part by a Community Conservation Partnerships Program grant under the administration of the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Bureau of Recreation and Conservation, noting that (a) the project was completed in accordance with the Grant Agreement; (b) all project expenditures have been made and were in accordance with the Grant Application; (c) the Plan and related materials are acceptable to the City of Erie and (d) the Plan and related materials will be used to guide future recreation and conservation decisions.
