1. Council File Ordinance #15,517, Pending Official File Ordinance #26-2007  
An ordinance appropriating the sum of **\$200,000.00** from unappropriated and anticipated revenue from Account #501-0000-0000-3303 Federal Operating Grant - HUD CDBG/ARC and providing for the expenditure thereof by allocating said funds to Account #501-1201-2006-4569 Technology Incubator.
2. Council File Ordinance #15,519, Pending Official File Ordinance #28-2007  
An ordinance appropriating the sum of **\$320,000.00** from unappropriated and anticipated revenue to be received from the registration of rental units as required by Ordinance 73-2006, the Landlord Licensing Ordinance from Account #002-0000-0000-3223 Revenue and providing for the expenditure thereof by allocating said funds to various #002-0205-0000-40xx accounts.

1. Resolution sponsored by Council President Rubye Jenkins-Husband paying special tribute to **Mr. John Kanzius** for developing a radio wave generator that, in tests conducted on animals, destroyed aggressive cancer cells, and endorsing his efforts and that of **Community United for a Cancer Cure** to continue research and fund raising to achieve a successful result in the fight to cure cancer.  
  
2. Resolution authorizing and directing the Mayor and appropriate City officials to submit an application to the PA. Department of Community and Economic Development, under the Pennsylvania New Communities Program for a **Basic Grant of \$50,000** to be used in the operation of the **Erie Enterprise Zone** during the upcoming Fiscal Year July 1, 2007 - June 30, 2008 to enable the Zone Coordinator to provide loan and technical services to manufacturing and other business clients leading to job creation and job preservation.
3. Resolution authorizing the Mayor and other appropriate City Officials to submit an application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for Funding Opportunity Number FR-5100-N-20A, the **Lead Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program**, in the sum of **\$3,000,000**. Application to be submitted by May 14, 2007.
4. Resolution for a proposed **Repository Sale** of property located at 655 East 18<sup>th</sup> Street, Erie, PA. (Index #18-050-024.0-205.00) by the Erie County Tax Claim Bureau to Luther R. Manus, Jr., in the amount of \$1,000.
