She was a dedicated wife, mother, and grandmother whose keen intelligence, kind heart, and quiet strength will be sorely missed by all whose lives she touched; and

WHEREAS, Barbara Jean Faccone was a very generous and giving soul who loved her family above all else. Her joy came from seeing her husband, children, and grandchildren succeed. She relished in attending her children's academic milestones, swim meets, and football games and even more so in her grandchildren, strongly encouraging their education and cheering them in their numerous activities. She loved attending school concerts, hockey and lacrosse games, wrestling meets and dance recitals, and playing Candyland; and

WHEREAS, Barbara Jean Faccone also loved her crossword puzzles and could often be found nestled on her couch, nightly, with one of them in hand confidently scribbling down her answers in pen. She also enjoyed cooking. Her southern fried chicken, gravy, wheat pie, and the various marinades that she made will never be duplicated.
