IN MEMORIAM

DEMETRIUS MOZELIAK

WHEREAS, Demetrius Mozeliak of Bloomfield, New Jersey, is being remembered upon his passing from this life on Saturday, April 18, 2020, at the age of 83 of complications from COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Demetrius Mozeliak affectionately called "Nick" by his family and friends was born in Simpson, Pennsylvania, on November 17, 1936, to Julia and Metro Mozeliak. He lived in Simpson, Pennsylvania, until he attended college with his brother John. He attended and graduated from Pennsylvania State University where he was a very proud alumnus and moved to New York for work post-graduation; and

WHEREAS, Demetrius Mozeliak served in the United States Army as a counter-intelligence officer from 1958-1962. He went on to receive his MBA from New York University. In 1970, he moved to the suburbs of Manhattan, where he settled down for the next 35 years in Glen Ridge, New Jersey. In later years, he split his time between his homes in Pennsylvania and Bloomfield, New Jersey, to be closer to his two daughters and their families after living in Arizona early in his retirement years; and

WHEREAS, Demetrius Mozeliak spent most of his career in IT working for NBC, International Nickel, BASF, and International Paper Company before retiring from Prudential in 2003, where he served as the Vice President of Delivery. Most fall Saturdays you could find him rooting for his Penn State Nittany Lions; and

WHEREAS, Demetrius Mozeliak is survived by Lynne (ex-wife); and their two daughters, Leigh (Mark) and Nicole (Tom); and four grandchildren who will miss him terribly. He is also survived by his brother John and sister-in-law Anne; and his three nieces and nephews and their families. He is pre-deceased by his parents Metro and Julia and his granddaughter; as well as a host of other relatives, friends and colleagues; now, therefore, be it
