AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EWING IN THE COUNTY OF MERCER, TO AMEND CHAPTER 224 LITTERING § 224-6 VEHICLES AND TIRES TO ELIMINATE THE PROVISION PROHIBITING VEHICLES FROM BEING PARKED ON ANY RESIDENTIAL LAWN AND AMENDING CHAPTER 225 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II PARKING TO ADD § 225-10.3 PARKING PROHIBITED ON UNPAVED SURFACES ABSENT A SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Ewing, as follows:

§ 224-6. Vehicles and tires.

A. All vehicles shall be covered when necessary to prevent loads or residue from dropping, sifting, leaking, blowing out or otherwise escaping into the environment.

~~B. No vehicles of any kind whatsoever shall be parked on any residential lawn.~~

€ B. Tires may not be stored in the Township except in a fully enclosed structure or building.

§ 225-10.3 Parking prohibited on unpaved surfaces.

No person or property owner shall park, or give any individual permission to park, a motor vehicle on any unpaved surface on any property, whether the property be commercial, residential, or publicly owned property, absent a special events parking permit. A property owner may apply for a special events parking permit to allow short term parking on an unpaved surface when attendance at a special event is expected to exceed the available parking capacity or for other good cause. Application for a special events parking permit shall be made to the municipal clerk 30 days in advance of the special event. The special events parking permit shall be issued by the Township Council after review by the Police Department and the Code Enforcement Department.

STATEMENT

This Ordinance amends the Revised General Municipal Ordinances of the Township of Ewing to amend Chapter 224 Littering § 224-6 Vehicles and Tires to eliminate the provision prohibiting vehicles from being parked on any residential lawn and amending Chapter 225 Vehicles and Traffic, Article II Parking to add § 225-10.3 Parking prohibited on unpaved surfaces within the township absent a special events permit.
