ORDINANCE NO. 13-17

ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$640,000 PROCEEDS OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSES, IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS AND ACQUISITIONS IN AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF EWING, COUNTY OF MERCER, IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND TO AMEND BOND ORDINANCE #2012-13, FINALLY ADOPTED MAY 29, 2012 IN ORDER TO AMEND THE USEFUL LIVES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EWING, IN THE COUNTY OF MERCER, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39, it is hereby determined that \$640,000 of the proceeds of obligations originally made available pursuant to bond ordinance #2012-13 of the Township of Ewing, in the County of Mercer, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally adopted May 29th, 2012 ("Bond Ordinance #2012-13"), are no longer necessary for the purpose of acquiring the below listed items of equipment, for which the obligations previously were authorized.

Section 2. The \$640,000 described in Section 1 and made available pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39, is hereby re-appropriated to provide for the below listed improvements and acquisitions in and for the Township of Ewing, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.

Section 3. Section 3(e) of Bond Ordinance #2012-13 is hereby amended to read as follows:

e) Municipal Facilities:

Improvements to roofing and bathrooms, the acquisition and installation of carpeting and the acquisition and application of paint, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto. \$1,500,000 \$1,425,000 15 years

Section 4. Section 3(h) of Bond Ordinance #2012-13 is hereby amended to read as follows:

h) Parks:

Acquisition and installation of doors, roofing and siding improvements for park buildings, the acquisition and installation of bleachers at multiple parks and the acquisition and installation of a fence at Armstrong Park and the basketball court and improvements to the blacktop at the parks, including all work and materials necessary and incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto. \$308,500 \$293,075 15 years

Section 5. Section 6(b) of Bond Ordinance #2012-13 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(b) The average period of usefulness, computed on the basis of the respective amounts of obligations authorized for each purpose and the reasonable life thereof within the limitations of the Local Bond Law, is 10.69 years.

Section 6. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
