AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED GENERAL MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EWING, IN THE COUNTY OF MERCER, TO PROHIBIT AND REGULATE PARKING ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS DURING SNOW EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Ewing that the Revised General Municipal Ordinances of the Township of Ewing be amended to prohibit and regulate parking on residential streets during states of emergency:

Section 1: Section 225-6, entitled “Parking Prohibited During State of Emergency” of the Revised General Municipal Ordinances of the Township of Ewing is hereby amended, as follows:

A. No change to text of subsection A.

B. No change to text of subsection B.

C. New section: Whenever snow has fallen and accumulation is such that it covers the street or highway, no vehicle shall be parked on any residential street in the Township. For residential streets wherein off-street parking is available, the parking prohibitions shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased until the streets have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic. For residential streets wherein off-street parking is not available, as described in Schedule II, § 225-49, as seen below and made a part of this chapter, the parking prohibitions shall remain in effect for alternate sides of the residential streets as described in Schedule II, § 225-49, after the snow has ceased until the streets have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.
