ORDINANCE NO. **11-18**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EWING, COUNTY OF MERCER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REMOVING THE POSITION OF HEALTH OFFICER FROM TITLE 11, CIVIL SERVICE

WHEREAS, the Township desires to remove the position of health officer from Title 11, Civil Service.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Township of Ewing, in the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, that Ewing Township Code § 392-5 shall be revised as follows:

§ 392-5. There shall be a Health Official of the Board of Health who shall be responsible to the Board. The Health Official shall hold the necessary license ~~and shall be appointed in accordance with the provisions of Title 11A, Civil Service, of the New Jersey Statutes.~~ The Health Official shall, subject to the superior authority of the Board, be the general agent of the Board for the enforcement of its ordinances and the sanitary laws of the State of New Jersey.

Section 1. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication according to law.

STATEMENT

This Ordinance removes the position of health officer from Title 11, Civil Service.
