#### **Accept Nominees for Fenwick Island Town Council**

Audrey Serio, Board of Elections Inspector, informed Town Council there were three candidates for the upcoming term. They are incumbents Gardner Bunting, Vicki Carmean and Bernie Merritt. Ms. Serio stated they are all certified as qualified to serve on Town Council and announced there will be no Town election for the upcoming term.

A MOTION was made by Vice Mayor Mais, seconded by Council Member Carmean to accept the proposed three candidates for the upcoming term. The MOTION passed unanimously.

#### **President's Report**

Mayor Langan gave an update to the beach replenishment schedule. The dredging is now to begin on July 28<sup>th</sup> and is expected to finish by mid-August. There is additional work to be done on restoring the crossovers that will continue after the dredging is complete. Any changes with the schedule will be posted on the Town's website, Facebook and Twitter.

Town Manager Tieman has been in touch with Verizon and is awaiting final plans on the installation of new poles for small cell technology. No work is expected to begin until the fall.

Mayor Langan stated there were flyers on the table regarding a meeting to be held on July 12<sup>th</sup> at the Bethany Beach Ocean Suites to discuss offshore wind in Delaware. The meeting will be from 8:00 a.m. to noon. Town officials will be in attendance to hear from experts in the environmental, social and technology areas. Space is limited, and reservations are required. For those who may not be able to attend this meeting, another meeting will be held on June 27<sup>th</sup> at the Rehoboth Beach Convention Center.

Mayor Langan attended the Association of Coastal Towns (ACT) meeting on June 22<sup>nd</sup>. Topics discussed included Charter items and current initiatives by other towns that encourage local restaurants to stop using plastic straws. The next meeting will be June 26<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m., in Lewes.
