Becca called the meeting to order at 8:30 AM.

Approval of Minutes

A motion was made by Nancy, seconded by Sharon, to accept the minutes from the May 23, 2018 meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion

Becca has obtained DJ Batman for his services at this year's bonfire. She asked the Committee to arrive no later than 6:30 PM to help with the set up. The guards will arrive around 7:00 PM to start the games, and the actual bonfire will start around 8:00 PM.

The bonfire will once again be held on the Dagsboro Street beach. Becca confirmed that Public Works will get the wood, and she requested 3 tables also be provided (1 for the dj and the other 2 for t-shirts). Public Works will also set up the lights over the dune crossing.

Craig Pfeifer once again will be donating some of the t-shirts. He will be providing a picture of the t-shirt design by the end of this week.

There will be no silent auction this year, but Nancy did send out letters to businesses asking for monetary donations. Ryk asked if the Committee still wanted the buoy signed by the lifeguards as an auction item. Nancy replied that the Committee still can do the buoy auction.

Becca confirmed the rain date for the bonfire as the following day (Sunday, July 7th), but asked who would make the call to postpone the bonfire. Ryk offered to make the call if there is bad weather or if he feels the conditions are unsafe.

All the proceeds raised from the bonfire will go towards the lifeguard competition to be held this year in Virginia Beach.
