

**ORDINANCE NO. 3646-A
(As Amended)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS 216 AND 488 OF THE
CODE OF THE CITY OF FOND DU LAC
TO ALLOW DOGS IN CITY PARKS**

The City Council of the City of Fond du Lac do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 216 Animals, Section 216-18., Prohibited areas for animals, is hereby repealed in its entirety and sections 216-19 to 216-24, renumbered accordingly.

Section 2. That Chapter 488, Parks and Recreation, Section 488-9., is hereby amended to read as follows:

- A. No person shall bring any animal into any City park, except in:
- (1) Lakeside Park on a leash no longer than 6 feet with an adult handler inside the Park, dogs are not allowed within 100 feet of the Main Street playground, the petting zoo or the deer pen area.
 - (2) Lakeside Park West in an area designated as an off-leash pet exercise area.
 - (3) Conjunction with a permit granted by the City under an applicable provision of this chapter or City Code. Organizers of Special Event located in City Parks may choose to prohibit dogs at their event. The organizers of the special event must appropriately sign the event to let dog owners know that dogs may not attend and have the responsibility of enforcing their prohibition.

Section 3. That Chapter 488, Parks and Recreation, Section 488-9., D. Dogs in parks., is hereby amended to read as follows:

- D. Dogs in parks. This section grants permission for dogs on leashes no longer than 6 feet with an adult handler to be in the following parks:
- (1) Colwert-Edward Park.
 - (2) Hucks Bellevue Park.
 - (3) Lakeside Park West.

- (4) Lallier Park.
- (5) Ledgeview Corporate Center.
- (6) McDermott Park.
- (7) Paul Butzen Park.
- (8) Plamore Park.
- (9) Russell Park.
- (10) Adelaide Park.
- (11) BMX Park.
- (12) Taylor Park.
- (13) Jefferson Park.
- (14) Lewis Park.
- (15) McKinley Park.
- (16) Brookfield Park.
- (17) Cardinal Park.
- (18) James 'Maggie' Megellas Park.
- (19) Hamilton Park.
- (20) Franklin Park.
- (21) Buttermilk Creek Park

Section 4. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to the penalty provided in § 1-4 of the Code.


Section 5. The appropriate City officials are hereby authorized and directed to take such action as is necessary to effectuate the terms of this Ordinance.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its passage and publication as provided by law.


