- 2 – Discussion about the Lakeland Park repairs requested by the Lakeland Little League.
- 3 – The Youth Center has given their approval for the Recreation Department to use their facility for our Summer Playground Program at no charge. At this time, we have 2 locations confirmed to run our program – the Youth Center and the Carno Center. We have not been given confirmation for use of Cherry Road School, but I have heard there will be multiple improvement projects on going during the Summer, making it difficult to hold a program at that location. The Program plans, procedures and guidelines are now being developed.
- 4 – Posted a notice to accept applications through May 7 for Summer Playground Program positions on Facebook. Jennifer has also posted a notice on indeed.com.
- 5 – The “To Do” list for the parks for the upcoming month of March and April (weather permitting) is ready. It has been submitted to the Highway Department and the Highway Chairman, listing the most important projects to be done as soon as possible.
- 6 – The Summer Concerts Series is being scheduled, with concerts being planned at this time, for Woods Road Park and Lakeland Park, as we have not received permission to utilize the field at Cherry Road School. Our youth sports (lacrosse, tennis) are tentative, as we are attempting to find instructors.
- 7 – Possible re-opening of John Carno Recreation Center.. Obviously it will take some planning but to start work on guidelines, rules and regulations. Would we be able to open for certain programs, such as the Seniors having a monthly meeting during the day?
