

1 TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON

ORDINANCE NO.: #1894-2019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 144 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO PROVIDE FOR OR AMEND THE FEES FOR CERTAIN CONSTRUCTION PERMIT APPLICATIONS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hamilton, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey that Chapter 144 of the Code of the Township of Hamilton, entitled Constructions Codes, Uniform, shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Amend section 144-3 (Fees) subsection B to read as follows:

§ 144-3. Fees.

B. The basic construction fee shall be the sum of the parts computed on the basis of volume or cost of construction, the number of plumbing fixtures and pieces of equipment, the number of electric fixtures and the number of sprinklers, standpipes and detectors (smoke and heat) at the unit rates provided herein, plus any special fees.

(1) [Unchanged]

(2) Plumbing fixtures and equipment. The fees shall be as follows:

Use	Fee
(a) Each fixture, piece of equipment or appliance connected to the plumbing system, and for each appliance connected to the gas piping or oil piping system, except as indicated in §144-3.B.(2)(b) below.	\$15 per item, minimum of \$60
(b) Special devices, including but not limited to: Grease traps, oil separators, refrigeration units, utility service connections, backflow preventers equipped with test ports (double check valve assembly, reduced pressure zone, and pressure vacuum breaker backflow preventers), steam boilers, hot water boilers (excluding those for domestic water heating), active solar systems, sewer pumps and interceptors. There shall be no inspection fee charged for gas service entrances.	\$91 per special device

(3) [Unchanged]

Section 2. Repealer. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances of Hamilton Township heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. Severability. If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this Ordinance, or any other ordinance enacted together with this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgement shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this Ordinance, and of other ordinances enacted together with this Ordinance, are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 4. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, adoption and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
