A Resolution confirming the re-appointment of Mr. Calobe Jackson, Jr. to serve on the Harrisburg Planning Commission.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3 of 1970, passed by City Council on March 10, 1970, established the Harrisburg Planning Commission pursuant to the provisions of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission shall be comprised of seven (7) members to be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of Council pursuant to section 7-101.2 of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Harrisburg has re-appointed Mr. Calobe Jackson, Jr. to serve on the Harrisburg Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the re-appointment shall be for a one (1) year term expiring on March 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jackson is a resident of the City of Harrisburg; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jackson holds no employment within the City of Harrisburg government nor with any related entity; and

WHEREAS, the qualifications of Mr. Jackson to serve in such capacity have been reviewed and considered by Council; a copy of Mr. Jackson's résumé which sets forth his qualifications is attached hereto and marked "Exhibit A."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISBURG that the Council hereby confirms the re-appointment of Mr. Calobe Jackson, Jr. to the Harrisburg Planning Commission for a one (1) year term expiring on March 31, 2015.


