

RESOLUTION NO. 105 of 2014

Moved by: Wanda R. Williams

A Resolution supporting both the Pennsylvania House Bill 2182 and Senate Bill 1182 proposed legislation, permitting the medicinal use of cannabis (medical marijuana) as prescribed by a practitioner licensed in the state of Pennsylvania.

**WHEREAS**, in June 2014, the Senate Law and Justice Committee voted unanimously to pass Senate Bill 1182 establishing access to medical marijuana in Pennsylvania; and

**WHEREAS**, twenty-two states and Washington, D.C have adopted legislation legalizing the use of medical marijuana with proper oversight; and

**WHEREAS**, the most recent poll regarding the use of medicinal marijuana conducted by Franklin and Marshall College indicates that approximately 85% of Pennsylvania citizens support adopting legislation legalizing the use of medicinal marijuana; and

**WHEREAS**, such legislation would meet the needs of Pennsylvania citizens suffering from conditions and chronic illnesses that are best addressed with medicinal marijuana; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISBURG** that the Council hereby supports both the Pennsylvania House Bill 2182 and Senate Bill 1182 proposed legislation, permitting the medicinal use of cannabis (medical marijuana) as prescribed by a practitioner licensed in the state of Pennsylvania.
