A Resolution approving an Intergovernmental Agreement of Sale for the purchase of a 1984 Sutphen Pumper Fire Engine from Swatara Township, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, Swatara Township, Pennsylvania ("Seller") is the owner of a 1984 Sutphen Pumper Fire Engine ("Engine"); and

WHEREAS, the Seller desires to sell the Engine; and

WHEREAS, the City's Fire Department has determined that it can make good use of the Engine and;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to purchase the Engine; and

WHEREAS, the Seller has proposed to sell the Engine to the City for \$3,500.00 as set forth in an Intergovernmental Agreement of Sale ("Agreement") which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUCL OF THE CITY OF HARRISBURG, that the Intergovernmental Agreement of Sale is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, Controller, and other appropriate City officials are authorized to take all steps necessary to effectuate the purpose of this Resolution.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT OF SALE

This AGREEMENT made this ____ day of _____, 2014, between the TOWNSHIP OF SWATARA, a First Class Township Municipal Corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with its principal office located at 599 Eisenhower Boulevard, Swatara Township, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania 17111 (“Swatara”), and the CITY OF HARRISBURG, a Municipal Corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with its principal office located at 10 North 2nd Street, Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania 17101 (the “City”).

WHEREAS, Swatara is the owner of a 1984 Sutphen Pumper Fire Engine; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Swatara Township has determined that its 1984 Sutphen Pumper Fire Engine is no longer necessary for use by the Township in fighting fires or for any other reason; and

WHEREAS, the City, through its council, has determined that the aforesaid 1984 Sutphen Pumper Fire Engine may be utilized by the Harrisburg Bureau of Fire; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the First Class Township Code (53 P.S. §56501.II), Swatara is permitted to sell personal property without advertising for bid or sale at public auction to a City; and

WHEREAS, Swatara desires to sell its 1984 Sutphen Pumper Fire Engine to the City, which the City desires to purchase.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the covenants herein contained, and intending to be legally bound, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Swatara will sell by conveyance of title its 1984 Sutphen Pumper Fire Engine, VIN #1S9ABDD8E1003200, to the City for the sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00).
2. The sale of the aforesaid Sutphen Pumper is made “as is”, contingent, however, on the pumper passing a standard Pennsylvania vehicle inspection applicable to fire engines.

3. Swatara warrants that it is the true and lawful owner of the 1984 Sutphen Pumper Fire Engine, has the full power and authority to sell the same, and that said vehicle is free and clear of all liens and encumbrances.

4. The City warrants that it has the full power and right to purchase the Sutphen Pumper and has taken all actions necessary and/or required under Pennsylvania law and its home rule charter necessary to purchase the pumper.
