

RESOLUTION NO. 81 - 2016

A Resolution to recognize the historical significance of the Broad Street Market to the City of Harrisburg and support the transition of Market operations from a for-profit to a not-for-profit model through the Broad Street Market Alliance.

WHEREAS, the Broad Street Market is recognized as an institution in the City of Harrisburg that has ably served generations of residents and visitors in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Harrisburg is the owner of the land and buildings that comprise the Broad Street Market and the City retains a significant interest in its continued operations; and

WHEREAS, for more than 20 years the operation of the Broad Street Market had been undertaken by the Broad Street Market Corporation, a for-profit entity responsible for the daily management of the facility; and

WHEREAS, a transition to a not-for profit model of operation has been undertaken and a new entity – the Broad Street Market Alliance – has been formed to perform the daily management and operations of these important public facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City has proposed to undertake a formal agreement with the Broad Street Market Alliance to assure the ongoing success of the Market and facilitate plans to address the significant upgrades and improvements to the facilities while preserving the Market's important historical role in the City; and

WHEREAS, for these reasons and in recognition of the Market's unique place in local history and the daily life of our citizens, the Council wishes to publicly support the transition of these operations to a not-for profit model and thereby help preserve this local institution; and

WHEREAS, as part of that support, the City Council now declares this public property shall continue to operate as a public Market and shall hereinafter forever be known as the Broad Street Market.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISBURG, that the transition of the operations of the Broad Street Market from a for-profit to a not-for profit model is hereby endorsed and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the formation of the new Broad Street Market Alliance to operate the City-owned Market is acknowledged.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in honoring the unique role it occupies in the history of Harrisburg, the facilities now known as the Broad Street Market is hereby recognized for its longstanding service to the people of this City and the Council **NOW DECLARES** that these facilities shall hereinafter and forever be known within the records and operations of this City as the **“Broad Street Market.”**
