

RESOLUTION NO. 7 - 2017

A Resolution appointing Thomas Whye, PE to serve on the Building and Housing Code Board of Appeals of the City of Harrisburg.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg § 8-501.1, the City of Harrisburg shall appoint five (5) members to the Building and Housing Code Board of Appeals of the City of Harrisburg (the "Board"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 8-501.1.A., appointments to the Board shall be made by the Mayor with the advice and consent of Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 8-501.1.B., appointees to the Board shall be residents of the City of Harrisburg and shall serve for a term of three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 8-501.1.C., appointees to the Board shall hold no other office or employment in the government of the City or serve on any of its boards, commissions, or authorities; and

WHEREAS, reposing confidence and trust in the ability of Thomas Whye, PE to capably perform the duties incumbent upon the position, the Mayor has appointed Mr. Whye to serve on the Board; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Whye is a resident of the City of Harrisburg; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Whye holds no other office or employment in the government of the City or serves on any of its boards, commissions, or authorities; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to § 8-501.1.C., Mr. Whye's appointment shall be for the remainder of the term formerly held by Mr. Glen Dunbar expiring on November 10, 2018; and


WHEREAS, Mr. Whye's qualifications to serve as a member of the Building and Housing Code of Appeals of the City of Harrisburg have been reviewed and considered by Council. A copy of Mr. Whye's resume is attached and incorporated as "Exhibit A."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISBURG, that the appointment of Thomas Whye, PE to serve on the Building and Housing Code Board of Appeals of the City of Harrisburg is confirmed.
