

RESOLUTION NO. 10 - 2017

Moved by: Walter R. H. Williams

A Resolution appointing Neil Heffelfinger to serve on the Harrisburg Architectural Review Board.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg § 7-317.4, the City of Harrisburg shall appoint seven (7) members to the Harrisburg Architectural Review Board (the "Board"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 7-317.4.A., the members of the Board shall consist of one (1) registered architect, one (1) licensed real estate broker, (1) one Building Inspector of the City; and four (4) additional persons with a knowledge of and interest in preservation of the Historic Overlay District; and

WHEREAS, appointments to the Board shall be made by the Mayor with the advice and consent of Council; and

WHEREAS, appointees to the Board shall be residents of the City of Harrisburg; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 7-317.4.C., appointees to the Board shall serve for a term of three (3) years or for the unexpired portion of a vacated term; and

WHEREAS, Neil Heffelfinger is a resident of the City of Harrisburg; and

WHEREAS, reposing confidence and trust in the ability of Mr. Heffelfinger to capably perform the duties incumbent upon the position, the Mayor has appointed Mr. Heffelfinger to serve on the Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 7-317.4.C., Mr. Heffelfinger's appointment shall be for the remainder of the term formerly held by Mr. Michael Snyder expiring on September 25, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Heffelfinger's qualifications to serve as a member of the Harrisburg Architectural Review Board have been reviewed and considered by Council. A copy of Mr. Heffelfinger's resume is attached and incorporated as "Exhibit A."




