

RESOLUTION NO. 18 - 2018

A Resolution reappointing Mr. Garvey Presley, Jr. to serve on the Capital Region Water, a municipal authority, Board of Directors ("CRW Board").

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to The Municipal Authorities Act § 5610(a)(1), appointments to the CRW Board shall be made by the Mayor with the approval of City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to The Municipal Authorities Act § 5610(b)(1), appointees to the CRW Board must be a taxpayer in, maintain a business in, or be a citizen of the City of Harrisburg or a municipality into which the authority extends; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Presley is a resident and taxpayer of the City of Harrisburg; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Presley is not an employee of the City of Harrisburg; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Presley's qualifications to serve on the Board have been carefully reviewed and considered by City Council. A copy of Mr. Presley's resume is attached and incorporated as "Exhibit A;" and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Presley has worked for the Derry Township Municipal Authority for over 24 years; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Presley has addressed wastewater issues in his position as Operator II for the Derry Township Municipal Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Presley has taken continuing education courses in order to maintain a Class A Wastewater Treatment Operator Certification; and


**WHEREAS**, Mr. Presley has served as a member of the CRW Board;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to The Municipal Authorities Act § 5610(a)(1), the terms of CRW Board members are staggered; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to The Municipal Authorities Act § 5610(a)(1), a CRW Board member shall be appointed to a five year term "from the date of expiration of the prior term"; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Presley's term on the CRW Board expired on January 4, 2018;


