A Resolution authorizing the execution of a federal aid reimbursement agreement with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) for the acceptance of Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Funding for the Herr Street Pedestrian Access Route Project.

WHEREAS, the City applied for PennDOT TAP Funding for the Herr Street Pedestrian Access Route Project; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the project is to improve the sidewalk system and provide safer, ADA-compliant pedestrian crossings on Herr Street between Cameron Street and North 15th Street; and

WHEREAS, by way of Resolution 9-2016, this Council ratified the submission of a grant application to PennDOT for the Herr Street Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Harrisburg has been awarded \$ 327, 881 in Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Funding for the Herr Street (SR 3018) Pedestrian Access Route Project; and

WHEREAS, the PennDOT TAP Funding award requires a municipal designee to electronically execute the PennDOT TAP Funding Reimbursement Agreement in order to effectuate the award.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISBURG, that acceptance of the PennDOT TAP Funding is approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Controller are authorized to execute a designation, hereto attached as 'Exhibit A,' that the City Engineer, Wayne S. Martin, is authorized to sign and execute on behalf of the City of Harrisburg, any and all materials required for execution via PennDOT's Reimbursement Agreement System (RAS) for the requested federal aid reimbursement agreement # _____ and any required supplements between the City of Harrisburg and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation and have the same delivered to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.


