WHEREAS, Ms. Little was initially appointed to serve on the HHRC a one-year term which expired on November 14, 2018; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor to reappoint Ms. Gretchen M. Little to serve on the HHRC pursuant to the provisions of law for an additional one-year term; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Little's reappointment shall be for a one-year term expiring on November 14, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISBURG that the City Council hereby confirms the reappointment of Ms. Gretchen M. Little to the Harrisburg Human Relations Commission ("HHRC") for an additional one-year term.

Gretchen Little has lived one full life (presenting as male), and is embarking on another (presenting as female). A licensed attorney in Pennsylvania since 1992, Gretchen (formerly Max) holds undergraduate degrees in Broadcast/Film Art and English from Southern Methodist University in Dallas TX. She worked in local cable TV programming in Ft. Worth, TX, before studying law at the University of Pittsburgh.

She served as an assistant district attorney in Bradford County, PA before receiving a judicial appointment as district attorney in Sullivan County, PA. She then won election to that office three times, before moving to Harrisburg in 2008 to establish the Traffic Safety Resource Prosecutor program at the PA District Attorneys Association.

She is semi-retired, and serves as Secretary of the Central PA LGBT Center's Board of Directors. She has co-authored a Practice Guide on PA DUI law, and works with the Pennsylvania Department of Corrections facilitating a monthly teleconference support group for transgender inmates.

An accomplished roller derby announcer, Gretchen regularly lends her talents to women's roller derby leagues in Harrisburg, Lancaster, Hanover, and York PA. She has also announced at the Women's Flat Track Derby Association (WFTDA) international playoffs since 2011. In addition to roller derby, she also enjoys playing tennis, seeing live music, and singing karaoke.
