

RESOLUTION NO. 13 - 2019

A Resolution approving the disposal or donation of certain personal property owned by the City of Harrisburg which has exhausted its useful life for City operations, or has nominal value, no value, or less value than the disposal cost.

WHEREAS, periodically the City will have certain personal property which is no longer able to be used for public or municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the director of any department or bureau may identify and recommend disposal of City owned machinery, equipment, or materials that are obsolete or in disrepair; and

WHEREAS, Section 12402.1 (c) of the Third Class City Code provides that “[n]o personal property of the city shall be disposed of, by sale or otherwise, except upon approval of council by resolution[;]” and

WHEREAS, Section 12402.1 (e)(1) of the Third Class City Code provides that, for personal property valued in excess of \$2,000, the requirement to advertise for bids and sell to the highest bidder shall not apply when the personal property is being sold to “[t]he Federal Government, the Commonwealth, a municipality, home rule municipality, institution district or school district;” and

WHEREAS, certain personal property owned by the City specifically set forth and described in Exhibit “A” is proposed for sale to the Pennsylvania Attorney General’s Office for \$200 per item, therefore, not requiring advertisement for bid; and

WHEREAS, certain personal property owned by the City specifically set forth and described in Exhibit “B” has been identified as no longer able to be used and no longer holding value due to age and/or condition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISBURG, that the disposal of certain personal property owned by the City of Harrisburg attached as Exhibits “A” and “B” and incorporated as if fully set forth is approved and is to be implemented immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, Controller, Finance Director and all other appropriate City officials are authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to effectuate this Resolution.
