

RESOLUTION No. 29 - 2019

A Resolution of the City of Harrisburg proclaiming May 5-11, 2019 as “Drinking Water Week” in the City of Harrisburg and encouraging all residents of the City of Harrisburg to celebrate the services that Capital Region Water provides to the City.

**WHEREAS**, the shared history of all peoples informs our society’s knowledge and understanding of the simple truth that water is our most valuable natural resource; and

**WHEREAS**, in the City of Harrisburg and the surrounding region, it has been the provision of reliable, on-demand tap water that has delivered to us all the oft forgotten benefits of protecting public health and aiding in fire suppression as well as supporting our economy and the quality of life we enjoy; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Harrisburg does recognize that by most any measure of a successful society – low mortality rates, economic growth and diversity, productivity, and public safety – our ongoing success is in some way related to our ready access to safe water; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Harrisburg further recognizes that we are all stewards of the systems and sources of fresh water and the indispensable infrastructure upon which our future generations will depend; and

**WHEREAS**, it should be known that each citizen of our City is called upon to help protect our sources of water from pollution, to practice responsible water conservation, and to become informed and involved in our local water issues, which is so essential to sustaining a healthy and vibrant collective future; and

WHEREAS, upon consideration of the foregoing, the City of Harrisburg wishes to recognize and acknowledge the vital role that Capital Region Water plays in supplying us all with a safe, abundant, affordable, and long-term supply of water to satisfy our people's daily and long-term needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN RECOGNITION OF THE TREMENDOUS VALUE THAT WATER SERVES IN THE LIVES OF ALL WHO LIVE, WORK, PLAY and VISIT IN THE CITY OF HARRISBURG, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISBURG, that May 5-11, 2019 be proclaimed as DRINKING WATER WEEK.
