Hillsborough Township Offers Free Clean Up Coupons for Residential Access to Facility

Annual Clean-Up Program to Begin in April, Coupons Available Beginning March 9th through April 30th

"It is that time of year for the Annual Hillsborough Township Clean Up and once again, this year, we are starting earlier", announced Deputy Mayor Greg Burchette, Liaison to Public Works at Tuesday's Township Committee Meeting.

Coupons and Senior Citizen stickers for the Township's Annual Clean Up will be available, beginning on Monday, March 9th at the Hillsborough Department of Public Works (DPW) office, located at 21 East Mountain Road, Monday through Friday 7 am to 3 pm and are distributed on a first come first serve basis. There are 150 coupons available per date. Senior Citizen Curbside service will begin on Monday, April 6th in the Northwest Section of town. Stickers are required for Senior Citizen Curbside service as well.

"We are always looking for ways to improve our programs and based on feedback from our residents, we are offering two Saturdays a month, beginning in April and running through October," added Deputy Mayor Burchette.

This program is for Hillsborough Residents only and proof of residency is required. The drop off site, located on Auten Road, across from the Auten Road Intermediate School, is open rain or shine on the specified dates.

The purpose of the clean-up program is to allow residents the opportunity to dispose of old furniture, toys, rugs, appliances, bicycles, yard debris, etc. Please note electronics and hazardous materials are NOT accepted. For information on recycling electronics, hazardous waste and materials not permitted at the Auten Road facility, residents can contact Somerset County Recycling Department at 732-469-3363 or visit their website at www.co.somerset.nj.us/recycle.

The schedule of when and where curbside pickup will take place, and regulations regarding both curbside pickup and the Auten Road drop-off program, are available on the Township's website, www.hillsborough-nj.org, by calling DPW at 369-3950 and are attached to this press release.

- MUST SHOW PROOF OF RESIDENCY AND VEHICLE REGISTRATION OF THE VEHICLE TO BE USED.
- DUMP HOURS ARE FROM 7:00AM – 3:00PM.
- DUMP IS OPEN RAIN OR SHINE.
- RESIDENTS MUST PRESENT COUPON AT DUMP SITE (THERE WILL BE NO ACCESS TO THE DUMP SITE WITHOUT THE COUPON).
- CURBSIDE PICK UP IS FOR SENIOR CITIZENS ONLY (MUST BE 65 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER) WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF HILLSBOROUGH TOWNSHIP (REFER TO SENIOR CURBSIDE PICKUP RULES AND REGULATIONS).

1. COUPONS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE PUBLIC WORKS OFFICE MONDAY TO FRIDAY FROM 7:00AM – 3:00PM AND ALSO AT THE MARCH SENIOR MEETINGS.
2. SENIOR RESIDENTS MUST BE 65 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER.
3. SENIOR RESIDENTS MUST PRESENT PROOF OF RESIDENCY (DRIVER'S LICENSE WILL DO).
4. STICKERS WILL BE ISSUED:
 - A. TEN (10) ITEMS MAXIMUM (BOXED OR BUNDLED ITEMS COUNT AS ONE).
 - B. ONE STICKER PER ITEM.
 - C. NO STICKER REQUIRED FOR BRUSH.
5. ITEMS WITHOUT A STICKER WILL BE LEFT.
6. ITEMS ADDED TO YOUR PILE BECOME YOUR RESPONSIBILITY (WATCH YOUR PILE)
7. PLACE YELLOW TICKET (COUPON) IN WINDOW OR DOOR.

PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE THE FOLLOWING AT THE CURB – IT CANNOT BE PICKED UP BY DPW:
