Artist and longtime Hillsborough Township resident, Doreen Lorenzetti has been drawing since she was a child. Ms. Lorenzetti illustrated the Map 20 years ago and will be spearheading this Anniversary Edition.

“There have been many new businesses in Hillsborough over the last 20 years and this is a great opportunity to have this updated,” stated Deputy Mayor Greg Burchette, during the announcement at the Township Committee meeting.

The new map will not cost the Township taxpayers any money as funding for printing will come from those businesses and organizations that wish to have their location highlighted.
